LISMORE & DISTRICT NETBALL ASSOCIATION REPRESENTATIVE OFFICIALS POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

1. All coaches must hold a current development accreditation or higher (netball specific) and have had 12 months as an assistant coach within the Lismore & District Netball Association (as per Association Constitution). Lismore & District Netball Association Representative Coaches cannot officiate in any capacity for other Associations Representative teams.
2. All Representative Team Officials must abide by the Child Protection Act and complete the Working with Children Check Consent Form together with the Member Protection Form.
3. A maximum of 2 common training sessions per week will be held with one being Wednesday night, of no more than 2 hours duration. If a team is not training on the common training night (Wednesday) the team coach must advise the Representative Coordinator why training has been cancelled for the night.
4. Team coaches must return the completed team carnival and championship booklets at the completion of the representative season, these booklets are the official record of attendance at training and games played at carnivals and State & State Age Championships and remain the property of Lismore & District Netball Association.
5. Representative Coaches must abide by the Netball NSW minimum game playing rule at State Age Championships, any Coach found breaching this rule will be held personally liable for any and all fines imposed by Netball NSW and will face the Lismore & District Netball Association Judiciary Committee.
6. Team Officials must not instigate unnecessary contact with players, team officials should avoid situations where they may be alone with a child i.e. dressing rooms, bedrooms or if transporting children in private vehicles which is not recommended ensure that there is more than one adult in the vehicle.
7. One on one coaching with representative team/squad member is not permitted outside the gazetted common twice-weekly training sessions when other team officials are in attendance, all team bonding/meeting must be held at the Lismore & District Netball Association Club house or other public place.
8. Representative Officials **MUST ONLY OFFER BASIC FIRST AID** to players (unless suitably qualified) i.e. bandaids, antiseptic and icepacks etc. for management of **MINOR** scratches, bruising and abrasions.

9. Representative Officials **MAY NOT ADMINISTERS MEDICATION TO PLAYERS UNLESS** Parent/Guardian gives written permission.

10. A minimum of two Team Officials must wait with any athletes who have not been collected by Parents/Guardians at the completion of training sessions or on return from carnivals or championships.

11. After State/State Age Championships in the year of representation all Representative Team commitments are terminated, with teams being disbursed and Team Officials no longer having any responsibility/organised activities with any representative members. Only one (1) post championship gathering may take place, which must be held in a public place i.e. restaurant, theme park or the Association Clubhouse a minimum of two team officials must be in attendance at all times.

12. All Lismore & District Netball Association Representative Coaches/Officials must be first registered members of Lismore & District Netball Association and abide by the Association Policies and Procedures.

13. Lismore & District Netball Association does not permit individual fundraising by teams or officials if teams are offered sponsorship/gifts by an organisation or person/official sponsorship/gifts must be given to all squad members.

14. All Association Representative Coaches must attend all carnival and training sessions as set down by the Association Representative Coordinator. Representative Coaches wishing to attend carnivals other than those gazetted by the Representative Coordinator must gain permission from Representative Coordinator to attend.

15. If a player withdraws/is withdrawn from a team, the coach of the team must consult with the Representative Coordinator before selecting a replacement player. The replaced player must be selected from players who have trialed with the team. A player who did not trial may be selected, only if there is no one who trialed for the position left vacant or can be utilised within the position left vacant.

16. Coaches must advise Representative Coordinator of the team's training times on the common Wednesday night and other selected training night.

17. Representative team coaches must inform the Association Representative Coordinator of all training aids used together with copies of any handouts the coach wishes to give to team members all of which must be approved by the Representative Coordinator prior to use or circulation.
