



Lismore netballers win a State title

THE Lismore and District Netball Association 14 years team has won Division 2 at the State Age championships at Blacktown in Sydney's west.

The association sent four teams to the championships – in 12, 13, 14 and 15 years – with all teams ranked in the top eight.

The 14 years team secured their title with outstanding netball across the championships.
